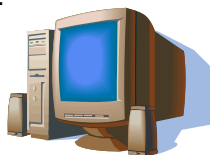
Mrs. Canaday's Physical Education classes just completed a Health unit on fitness components and goal setting. The class will be starting a hockey unit focusing on:

Attention students: Do you volunteer for TCMS, a club, your church, or your community? Then we would like to recognize you for your service. TCMS is participating in the **Presidential Volunteer Service Award**. If you accumulate and record 50 or more service hours within a 12 month period, then you are eligible for this recognition. TCMS will honor students who have accumulated 50 or more service hours from April 2010-April 2011. The exact deadline to submit service hours to Mrs. Bennett is **April 21, 2011** so that we can ensure enough time for ordering and delivery of awards.

Print as many as you may need. You can also pick up a Record of Service form from the bulletin board by Mrs. Bennett's office.

Once you create a profile, you can log in and update your Record of Service as needed. You will need a "Record of Service Key." ## Attention 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents:

### It's never too early to start thinking about IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SEVENTH GRADE FOR ENTRY INTO FLORIDA SCHOOLS:

The Florida Department of Health is requiring that students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade receive the Tdap vaccine (combined Tetanus, Diptheria and Pertussis Vaccines).

Documentation from the student's health care provider should specify that the student has received the Tdap vaccine on the Florida Certificate of Immunization, AKA "blue form". All incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders MUST submit this card prior to the first day of 7<sup>th</sup> grade.

The blue card can be turned in or mailed to the clinic or the front office. I always encourage parents to turn the form in early, rather than on the first day of school. Also, by law, I must have the actual blue card, not a photo copy. ( I will be happy to copy it for you ) If you have any questions please feel free to contact me.

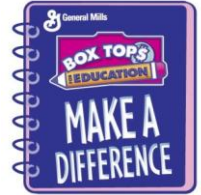

As soon as the first day of school for the 2011-2012 school year has been determined, we will update the list with the TBA dates and resend the form to you.

The Intent to Return is completed only by returning families, not those new to TCMS.

The Confirmation that your child will be in attendance on the first day of school survey is sent exactly three weeks prior to the first day of school to reconfirm that your child will be in attendance on that date. It is not the Intent to Return which we use to survey returning families in order to determine how many seats are available for the lottery.

If the documents are not received by the due date, your child's space will become available and a student on the waiting list shall be contacted.
