TCMS Administrative and Board policies closely govern a process for communicating with the parent of a student. TCMS also requires a student and his/her parent to acknowledge and agree to abide by any and all school and classroom policies and procedures.

Each school year your student receives a course syllabus for each of his/her core subjects. These syllabi contain information regarding classroom rules, grading procedures, handling of money for various class activities, and other policies pertaining to TCMS.

In order to save paper, your valuable time, and to allow for more ease in the process, your child will receive his/her core subject course syllabi and team handbook on line, as well as the laboratory/field science and handling of animals agreements for Science on line. Your child is responsible to access this information immediately, and along with you electronically sign off that you have read, fully understand and agree to abide by the requirements.

The process is very simple!

You may retype or simply copy and paste the agreement language shown below to an email address. Then send this new email with the information listed below in the box to your child's homeroom teacher at the teacher's TCMS email address. Be absolutely sure to include your child's and your names where referenced. Hit send and you are done! The response must clearly indicate that it was sent from the parent's email address.
